<p>Guidelines for Flex Funds FY19</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$5000 available July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019 • All information must be filled out on the form. Someone referring the family needs to follow through to get child registered and check to see if they are coming. • Ask Deanna how to deafferentation between Social Service respite funds and Collaborative respite funds. • Deadline for issuing funds for pool passes will be flexible based on funds available. Could use the option of day passes if request for a family pass is close to pool closing. • Go to work group for discretion as needed for any large request. • CCSS respite funds may not be used for other children in the home.
<p>Circle of Parents Brainstorming Components for startup.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Food will be purchased for meals utilizing Collaborative funds. May in future years ask for donations from various vendors. Pre-register for food count. • Evening time frame: twice a month; first half hour for networking and meal; 1 ½ hours for parent group and children care group. Will need two spaces, in close proximity. • Stipends – \$75 for facilitator, \$50 for child care providers. Katie Diiro and Amanda Hostad are interested in becoming facilitators. Stipends will be a gift card from local stores. Katie will look into college students who might want to provide child care or facilitate the group. • Training – Looking at possibly November 2nd/early November, Friday is the best.

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Agency Updates;

Collaborative: Resilience movie will be shown at the Barnesville Library on October 2nd; Moorhead Library on October 15th.

Lakeland Mental Health: The Center will be providing mental health services in the new correctional facility. A separate space will be available for mental health services.

Moorhead Schools: Duane attended the Compassion training for schools which was held in Fargo. Elementary schools are working on this topic as a second step after the trauma informed school training.

Clay County Social Services is hiring in child protection unit and case aide, due to job shifts. Mary Koskiniemi will be coming back from maternity leave. There is a slight increase in placements. County staff visited Olmstead County to observe and learn about their staffing intake calls. Clay County is adapting that format.

Restorative Justice: Referrals for the program are slightly down. The program will be partnering with the Moorhead Public Schools Horizon East school to provide Restorative Justice on site.

Summit Guidance: The agency has hired a couple of new therapists. There is a new counselor at the Ulen Hitterdal Public School. Mental health services four days a week. On Thursdays, two providers are working at the school. No mental health services on Fridays.
