The team has to be formed around the needs of the child so in order to have a team, the child must meet criteria. Barb and Alannah invited Katelynn to attend the all school staff meeting at Probstfield Learning Center in October. The event provides a place where Katelynn can share information on Wraparound.

A new brochure is being completed. Once ready for marketing, they should be placed in child study rooms at each of the school buildings. Information on the program could also be shared with the behavioral interventionists at the schools.
